**Martin Superior Court.**

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME OF HOLDING THE SPRING TERM OF THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF MARTIN, FOR THE YEAR 1871.

Sec. 1. That the General Assembly of North Carolina do hereby enact, that the Spring Term of the Superior Court for the county of Martin for the year 1871, shall be held on the first Monday after the third Monday in February.
