CITY OF RALEIGH, May 22, 1871.
THE FOLLOWING ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY is published for the information of all concerned:
AN ACT TO PROTECT THE CITY OF RALEIGH FROM AN INKERT BY FIRE.

SECTION 1. The General Assembly of North Carolina do hereby enact that the City of Raleigh shall have power to issue and sell bonds of the corporation, bearing interest not exceeding eight per cent, for the purpose of providing for the redemption of any bonds of the corporation (whether issued by the City or otherwise), length of time to run, and other incidents thereof, to be determined by the Commissioners of said City, said bonds not to exceed in the aggregate \$15,000. Provided, that said bonds shall not be sold at a discount greater than fifteen per cent.

SECTION 2. The proceeds of the sale of such bonds shall be applied to the making of any such bond in said City, to be located at such points as the Commissioners may determine, the same to be used for the purpose of adding a supply of water ready for the extinguishment of fires.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the Commissioners of the City of Raleigh to keep and collect an annual tax on real and personal property sufficient to pay the amount of interest and the principal of said bonds, and to discharge the principal in twenty years.

SECTION 4. These Trustees shall be elected by the Commissioners, two of whom shall be a Commissioner, and each of whom shall be the owner in his own right of at least \$2,000 real estate located in the City of Raleigh, for the purpose of managing and investing the proceeds of the tax levied for creating the aforesaid sinking fund.

SECTION 5. This act shall not go into operation until the first day of January next, and until such time as the Commissioners of the City of Raleigh, acting by a majority of the majority of the Commissioners, shall have passed a resolution to the effect that they have received from the State Treasurer the proceeds of the sale of the bonds of the City of Raleigh, in or United States bonds. The interest of such investment shall be credited to the City of Raleigh as fast as the same shall be collected.
