Follows in process which pack downward only, the weight of the lower roller when raised causing it to rise and strike the upper one. By the aid of the Toggle Joint the pull on the lever is no greater at the last than at the first, and two men will never lift more than 100 pounds into a bale which is 10 inches, 5 feet long.

It is so constructed that the ends opposite the bale may also be removed to put the Toggles on the ends before the pressure is taken off, thus causing a better shaped bale than can be made in a press having stationary ends.
