AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE SUPERIOR COURTS OF ALABAMA COUNTY.

The next session of the County Court of

January 1872 the Superior Courts for the

county of Alabama, shall be held on the sec-

ond Monday after the 1st of May of each

year.

That all process, recognizances and other legal process issued in civil and criminal

actions which have already been issued or may

hereafter be issued and had reference to

such actions, shall be deemed valid and

correct for the time of trial.

That all persons, officers or agents of the

Supreme Court of the State of Alabama, and

all other officers or agents of the County

Courts, shall be allowed to file their briefs

in General Assembly three times and

ratified the 4th day of December A. D. 1871.
