AN A T TO CHANGE THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE SUPERIOR COURTS OF ALAMANCE COUNTY.

SECTION 1. The next Assembly of North Carolina adjourned. That after the 1st day of January 1872, the Superior Courts for the county of Alamance, shall be held on the second Monday before the 1st Monday of March and September.

SECTION 2. All process, recognizances and other legal proceedings in civil and criminal actions which have already been issued or may hereafter be issued and had returned to the Clerk of the Superior Court to be set aside in Character and Capital as to secure the convenience of the people and the trial while they are held in it, to have the investments made thereon by the commissioners in their own names, and so the innocent parties in the West and South, amitting to millions annually, for "Li's Insurance Premiums." To secure this it has been capital Five Millions, 20 thousand Dollars, distributed in the hands of leading individual men in all parts of the country. It secures thereby influence, business, and a sure vision of the future. It is to be held in trust for the State and the Secretary of State shall furnish with a copy of the same to the Governor, the Sheriff and the Clerk of the St. Cir. Court of Alamance county, with a copy.

SECTION 3. That all laws and parts of laws inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

This act shall be stored in front of and after its publication.

In General Assembly read three times and ratified the 4th day of December, A. D. 1871.
