ANXAIT TO CHANGE THE TIME FOR THE TRIAL OF THE BOSTON BURNING CASE.

ALABAMA COUNTY.

No. 1. The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact: That after the 1st day of January 1872, the Superior Courts for the county of Alamance, shall hold their sessions on the 1st and 3d Monday of each month and September of each year.

No. 2. That all process, summonses and other legal proceedings in civil and criminal actions which have already been issued or made, and all other proceedings in the term Spring 1871 of said court, shall be deemed and held returnable to the term of said court as now fixed by this act; and all persons who have been summoned to appear before the court as now fixed, shall be required to appear before the court as now fixed, and the time of trial of the cause, and the date of trial, shall be determined by the Sheriff and the Clerk of the Superior Court of Alamance county, with a copy.

No. 3. That the laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act, hereby repealed and after its ratification.

In General Assembly read three times and ratified the 4th day of December, A.D. 1871.
