AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE SUPERIOR COURTS OF ALAMANCE COUNTY.

Sec. 1. The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact: That after the 1st day of January, 1872, the Superior Courts for the county of Alamance, shall be held on the second Monday before the last Monday of March and the third Monday before the last Monday of March.

Sec. 2. That all process, recognizances and other legal proceedings in civil and criminal actions which have already been issued or may hereafter be issued in the term of 1871 of said court, shall be deemed and held returnable to the term of said court as now fixed by this act; and all persons who have been recognized or bound in any manner in the year 1871, in the term of said court for the year 1872, are hereby required to appear at the term 1872, as provided in this act; and the Secretary of State shall forthwith cause this act to be published in the newspapers of the county of Alamance, and the Secretary of State, shall file a copy of the same with the Clerk of the Superior Court of the State; or the Clerk of Alamance county, with a copy.

Sec. 3. That all laws and parts of laws inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed and set aside. This act shall be enforced from and after its ratification.

In General Assembly read three times and ratified the 4th day of December, A. D. 1871.
