AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME FOR HOLDING THE SUPERIOR COURTS OF ALAMANCE COUNTY.

SEC. 1. The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact: That after the 1st day of January, 1872, the Superior Courts for the county of Alamance shall be held on the 2nd Monday before the 1st Monday of March, and thereafter, whenever improved.

Sec. 2. That all process, recognizances and other legal process issued or made, or criminal actions which have already been issued or may hereafter be issued, and had returned to the Clerk of Court, or to his agent, and all processes which have been issued or bound or committed to appear at the Spring Term of said court for the year 1872, are hereby required to appear at the term of the court for the year 1872; and the time of the said court for the year 1872, shall be published, and furnish the Clerk and the Clerks of the Superior Court of Alamance county with a copy.

Sec. 3. That this act, so far as laws inconsistent with it are hereby repealed, and it shall be enforced from and after its ratification.

In General Assembly read three times and ratified the 4th day of December, A. D. 1871.
