But this year, because of the absence of students from the State, the number of graduates was only thirteen. There were only thirteen graduates. But the style of their graduating essays, gave assurance that they had profited aright by their frequent opportunities of intercourse with their Professors. The vacancy in the chair of Mental and Moral Science was filled by the election of the Rev. James P. Lattner of Abbeville, S. C. Several North Carolinians and graduates of Davidson College were asked to be candidates for this professorship. But modest, or previous engagements prevented them from securing this post of honor and influence. Mr. Lattner is a young man highly commended for talents and attainments, by eminent lawyers, professors and ministers.

LEAF TOBACCO DEALERS.

As a matter of importance to many of our subscribers we publish the following:

In response to an inquiry, the Commissioner of Internal Revenue writes as follows to a wholesale dealer in leaf tobacco in New Orleans:

"Under the new law, as a dealer in leaf tobacco, you can assort leaf tobacco and repack it in hogsheads, cases, or bales of any size and weight you please. Such repacked cases, when you can sell to duly authorized dealers in leaf tobacco and cigar manufacturers who have paid the special tax as such, and to such persons as are known to be purchasers of leaf tobacco for export. But you cannot, under the new law, as a dealer in leaf tobacco, sell to parties other than those just named, or break hogsheads, cases, or bales, and retail therefrom."

This decision will be of interest to dealers in leaf tobacco, some of whom are uncertain as to how they shall, and what steps they shall take, under the new law, to stop the complaints of the cigar-makers.
