As an item of news for our cotton merchants and others, we condense from the Augusta Constitutionalist the following cotton statistics for the week ending Friday 23d.

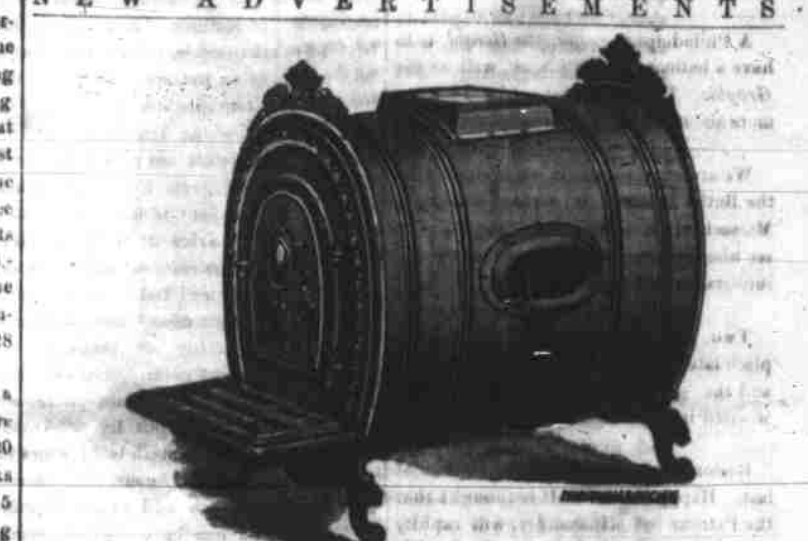
