HOMESTEADS.

James Wilson, a citizen of the State, claims that the homestead law is unconstitutional.

In providing a homestead of land for a family the Legislature ought ever to bear in mind, that the estate allowed, for this purpose should be protected by law.

Every homestead in land ought, therefore, to be a fee simple—that is an estate which the occupants would always feel disposed to improve.

Again, it is oftentimes the case, that the owner of the homestead sells or mortgages it to a stranger.

I am, therefore, decidedly of opinion, that the law ought to be so amended as to allow the reversion to be sold in two contiguous parcels.
