A DESTRUCTIVE INCENDIARY FIRE
WILLIAMSBURG, Pa.—A destructive incendiary fire occurred here at 1 o'clock this morning. It started in the piling yard of Brown & Co.'s saw mill, and destroyed lumber amounting to about twenty million feet piled on the ground. Several saw mills and planing mills and 14 frame houses were burned. The fire was gotten under control at 8 o'clock this morning. One man is reported as burned to death. The loss is estimated at 1 1/2 million of dollars, and the insurance is about \$150,000.

THE FLOOD IN THE MISSISSIPPI THE CREVASSES.
NEW ORLEANS.—A crevasse of 800 feet wide is reported at McChesney, two miles below Baton Rouge, on the left bank. The State engineers, who were despatched to the mouth of the Bayou Plaquemine to cut a dike which keeps the waters of the Mississippi out of Baton Rouge, had returned without executing his mission. The citizens of Iberville parish and the town of Plaquemine, in a public meeting protested against cutting the dike and resolved to prevent it by force. They have detailed a guard. It is now positively asserted by those best informed that the opening of Bayou Plaquemine will overflow the town of Plaquemine and the greater portion of Bertriville Parish, hence the opposition of the citizens.
