MORE OF CONSOLIDATION.

In another column will be found the proceedings of the Stockholders meeting to accept what is termed Consolidation. There were many more votes against Consolidation than we thought would be. It is clear that Billy Smith, Tom Scott, Buford and Swenson's holding of the stock is a serious obstacle to the consolidation. The North Carolina Corporation had character - until it was last secretly attempting to lease, and the President of the concern refusing to answer how much money was received for him on account of the lease.

That was self condemnation. When the corporation put forward Billy Smith to represent them, they say to the world we are no better than Billy.

The stockholders and directors should have remembered that only fifteen in the House, and nine in the Senate, were found to vote against the proposition to exclude dissenting men from the board of directors. We hold they cannot accept a part of the charter or Consolidation bill which puts the people's money and bonds in the corporation, without accepting also that clause which excludes Billy Smith.

That exclusion was as much a part of the bill as the clause allowing them to lease bonds. It was all but one act and must be received or rejected as one act. The Consolidation has nothing to do with it. If Gov. Caldwell can propose State as President of the Atlantic road, among the legislators whom that body have millions of property as a corporation, may he not disinherit them shall have control of the property.

### RAILROAD MAGNATES IN CONSIDERATION.

THE NORTH CAROLINA AND THE WESTERN NORTH CAROLINA RAILROADS.

PURSUANT to the call of the President of the North Carolina Railroad, joined by his Excellency, Governor Caldwell, the stockholders of the North Carolina Railroad held a general meeting at the town hall in Salisbury, on yesterday, to consider the consolidation of the North Carolina Railroad with the Western North Carolina Railroad.

On motion, Col. L. W. Humphrey, of Wayne county, was elected temporary chairman and A. H. Boyden, Esq., requested to act as secretary.

On motion, a committee, consisting of D. A. Davis, J. A. Chesley and J. H. Welburn, was appointed to verify the minutes. This committee, through their chairman, reported that a majority of the private stockholders were represented, and that the State was represented by Gen. Rufus Barringer, a duly authenticated proxy. On motion a permanent organization was effected with the officers last chosen.

The chairman explained the object of the meeting to be the consideration of the subject and the adoption or rejection of the act of the Legislature of 73-74, entitled "An act to amend the charter of the North Carolina Railroad" the adoption of which consolidation of the two roads into one company, and under one management. His Excellency, Governor Caldwell, presented the amended act in person, as required by the act itself, and he stated that he had appointed Gen. Rufus Barringer proxy for the State, whereupon Gen. B. presented his credentials. The Governor made some explanatory remarks in regard to the workings of the proposed amendments to the charter. He also took occasion to set forth his intentions, as the chief executive officer of the State, placing himself to carry out the law should the amended charter be accepted.
