A HAVANA LETTER.—THE PRISONER DOCKERY.—A DISPATCH FROM BILBOA.

CONFERENCE ON ARKANSAS MATTERS.—THE ATTORNEY GENERAL LEANS TO BAXTER.—RAILROAD BONDS INVOLVED.

WASHINGTON, May 9.—The Court of Enquiry acquitted General Howard Richardson in a home. The river and harbor appropriations will be reported on Monday.
