Seal to be provided at this office, until 15 M. of the 29th day of July, 1874, for furnishing and delivering at the site of the proposed court-house and post office at Raleigh, N. C., the dimension stone required for the exterior of the superstructure of the building, ready for setting, and as directed by the drawings and specifications.

The selection of one from which a selection

will be made will be confined to granite, limestone, freestones and sandstones, the quality of color, texture, durability, and the capacity for working under the chisel or hammer to a proper surface.

No stone that has not been tested by actual use as stone to build up or lay down

years will be considered, and absolute soundness of the material will be insisted upon.

Each stone must further have a good grain and be free from all discolouring substances, and the quarry from which it is procured must be fully exposed, and capable of furnishing the quality and quantity demanded within the time required by this advertisement.
