THE WAR MOVEMENT.

Washington, Sept. 4. Before leaving Washington last night, Attorney General Williams addressed a letter to the Secretary of War in the nature of a request to order the station of United States troops at certain points indicated by him, and where the Southern outposts have been the most violent.

This letter was today forwarded by Secretary Belknap to General McDowell, Commanding the Department of the South, together with the circular issued yesterday by the Attorney General, with instructions to do as directed.

Under his command are to insure the strict enforcement of its provisions, and the protection of both white and black citizens in their rights. Secretary Belknap also directed the Attorney General to order the station of United States troops at certain points indicated by him, and where the Southern outposts have been the most violent.
