

THE DANGER OF A REPUBLICAN VICTORY

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THE DOWNFALL OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY

Anybody who has for the last twelve months watched the progress of a political tide knows that the Republican party is rapidly sinking into a popular minority in the United States.

In this State last August, we witnessed victory from the Republicans, showing a total change of 10,000 votes, Caldwell's majority in 1873 having been 1,973, and Freely in 1874, 14,098. Freely polled 50,317 votes, Farnell but 54,181.

In New Hampshire, the change was more remarkable. In 1873 (Dray (Rep) beat the Democratic nominee for Governor 2,000 votes. In '74, Weston (Dem.) beat McMillan (Rep) 2,000 votes.

The revolution in Massachusetts is equally thorough and complete. Gest, a Democrat, was elected by a splendid majority—the first time in fifty years a Democrat has won the gubernatorial chair of the old Bay State.

In Ohio, New York, Connecticut, Oregon, Arkansas and other States, the Republican party has been defeated by a landslide.

In these bright days of Democratic ascendancy will North Carolina take a backward step? Will she return to the first embrace of the party she repudiated?

During the campaign last summer, the Republican candidate accused the people that Congress would not pass the civil rights bill, and if it did Grant would certainly veto it.
