THE THREE INDEPENDENTS

Maine, Wilson, Spake, and Hanson, are the three independent members of the Convention. Their independence means this—they ran and were elected without having received the nomination of either the Republican or Democratic Party.

Viewing their antecedents, their political affiliations in the past, we find that Dr. Edward Hanson was elected to the General Assembly of 1878-79 from the 24th Senatorial District—as a Republican.

Our investigation from the West makes it absolutely certain that he will act with the Conservative Party. He is a true Democrat, comes from a Democratic county, and through Democratic action of the State.

As to Dr. Wilson, of Ashe, the reports are conflicting. Both sides claim him. He was elected as a Democrat to the Legislature of 1871-72; he acted with our party in 1873; he was elected as an independent candidate.

Should these independent gentlemen act with the Democrats, as we have reason to believe they will, the desperate, revolutionary and wicked schemes of the Republicans to gain control of the Convention will be defeated, and a good government framed for North Carolina.

A fifty-page pamphlet entitled "An Attack Upon the Legislature of 1878-79" has been issued by Dr. Hawkins and his standing corporation known as the Chatham Road, and published at their law office, "Daily News print." The Legislature is not attacked by me, and never was.

In 1878 President Hawkins and his standing corporation offered to take up their mortgage bonds by putting in their place the Joint special tax bonds. In 1878 President Hawkins offered to take up his mortgage bonds with bonds issued in 1883, with the Constitution of America written on their face.

The retaining order was an order from which an appeal was taken to the Supreme Court, and there the case was for the present.

Dr. Hawkins and his standing corporation say the State is not injured by this exchange of bonds, and they try to prove it by the same amount of their mortgage bonds. In a few weeks they exchanged \$500,000 in bonds.

We then as attorney for the plaintiff applied to Judge Kerr for an injunction to stop this wholesale swindle. The Judge did so temporarily by a retaining order forbidding the Treasurer further to exchange bonds with Dr. Hawkins and his company.

The stockholders of the Chatham Road must not say we call them all swindlers. Only a few of them are swindlers, and say a few had anything to do with the law or ordinance in 1883 by which the swindle was put on foot.
