

Colonies.

The Convention adjourned till Tomorrow Morning 9 o' Clock.

FRIDAY, April 7, 1775.

The Convention met according to Adjournment.

Resolved, That the Moderator of this Convention, and in the Case of his Death Mr. Samuel Johnston, be empowered, on any future Occasion that may in his Opinion require it, to direct Delegates to be chosen for the respective Counties and Towns in this Province, to meet in Convention in the Town of Hillsborough, at such Time as he shall think proper to appoint; and in Case that the Members of a Majority of the Counties and Towns do not appear at the Day appointed, that he be empowered to adjourn the Convention de Die in Diem, until a sufficient Number shall appear.

Resolved, That the Clerk furnish Mr. James Davis with a Copy of the Proceedings of this Convention, and that Mr. Davis print the same.

Resolved, That this Convention do most heartily approve of the Conduct and Proceedings of the late Continental Congress, and will endeavour to carry into Execution the Measures by them recommended; and that the most earnest Wishes and Desires
