North-Carolina.

At a Convention of the Delegates for the respective Counties and Towns within this Province, held at Newbern the 6th Day of April, 1775.

Mr. Thomas Macknight, a Delegate for the County of Currituck having been called upon to sign (with the other Members of this Convention) the Association approved of by the Continental Congress, thereupon refused, and withdrew himself.

Resolved, That it is the Opinion of this Convention, that from the disingenuous and equivocal Behaviour of the said Thomas Macknight, it is manifest his Intentions are inimical to the Cause of American Liberty; and we do hold him up as a proper Object of Contempt to this Continent, and recommend that every Person break of all Connection, and have no future Commercial Intercourse or Dealing with him.
