How to Prosper.

We buy too much away. Our attention has been drawn to this subject by an examination of the statistics of the two canals.

There came to us through the A. & C. Canal, last year, 4,107 barrels of liquor and through the D. S. Canal 367 barrels.

Besides other articles already enumerated, there came to us through the A. & C. Canal, 1,084 barrels bread, 1,047 barrels mola-see, 3688 barrels sugar, 3,117 sacks coffee, 5,909 boxes hats and shoes, 6,203 boxes soap and candles, 4,655 boxes tobacco, 57,947 cubic feet dry goods, 2476 cubic feet hardware, 2,320 kegs nails, 245 crates ware, 1,012 casks lime, 71,520 bushels oyster shells, 61,291 pounds iron, 1,338 tons guano, 2,194 tons ice, 11,129 bags salt, 16,555 bushels salt, 2,486 barrels oil, 1,916 tons coal, 6,820 bushels agricultural lime, 106 tons railroad iron.
