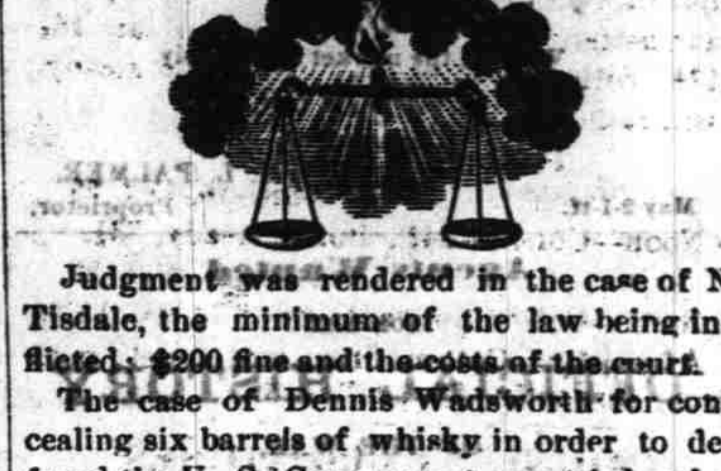
SUPERIOR COURT.—This Court did not convene yesterday until 2 o'clock in the afternoon, owing to the continued sickness of Judge Thomas.
