AN ORDINANCE

To lay Taxes and Provide for the Support of the City Government.

Enacted by the Mayor and Council of the City of New Berne, on the 15th day of October, 1868, a tax of one per cent upon the value of all real estate within the limits of the corporation, be and the same is hereby laid to be collected as by law provided.
