

AN ORDINANCE To lay Taxes and Provide for the Support of the City Government.

Sec. 1. It is ordained by the Mayor and Council of the city of New Bern, that for the fiscal year ending June 30th 1869, a tax of one per cent upon the value of all real estate within the limits of the corporation, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed as by law provided.
