


Death of Christopher Betchler.

The Charlotte Obarver speaking of him says : "Mr. Betchter was a somewhat historical character in Western North Carolina. He was a German by birth, and came to this country in (\$32 or 1833, about the time that the gold discoveries were made in Burke and Rutherford counties. In those days there was no mint or place for coinage of gold in this part of the country. Necessity suggested to an elder member of the family to establish machinery for the coinage of the quantity of gold then found in that part of the country. The success of that undertaking was remurkable. The Betchler coin was, well known and readily passed




