

GREAT SOUTHERN EXPOSITION.

What Days Will be Given to the Various States to Exhibit. EXPOSITION BUREAU, RALEIGH, N. C., Aug. 22.

The "State Day" at the Southern Exposition here, during the months of October and November, have been assigned as follows: South Carolina, October 1, 2 and 3.

Davidson, president State Farmers' Alliance; A. A. Poe, editor Fort Smith Daily Call. Georgia, October 19, 20 and 21, addresses by J. B. Huggins, assistant commissioner of agriculture; F. H. Richardson, editor Atlanta Journal; J. S. Hamilton, president Athens Manufacturing Company; L. F. Livingston, president Georgia State Alliance; R. F. Nesbit, commissioner of agriculture.

A number of the Governors other than Gov. Hogg, of Texas and Gay. Holt, of North Carolina, will be here. Col. A. K. McClure, editor Philadelphia Times, will deliver an address October 22. He was here some months before the State exposition of 1884 and aided largely in inaugurating it. Special "school days" have been set and teachers and scholars will find many interesting features presented. Distinct exhibits will be made by the schools of the South, and representatives of C. B. Denson, of Raleigh, and under the auspices of the Southern Educational Association. W. T. Harris, U. S. Commissioner of Education, will deliver address and will also have special displays made by his department. The Southern Educational Association has appointed the following committee to assist in making its exhibit a success: C. B. Denson, chairman, N. C.; J. B. McCohan, Md.; H. D. Huffaker, Tenn.; Mrs. S. Battle, State chemist of North Carolina, will make a special and instructive exhibit of chemicals and will have chemical tests made the time of this school exhibit.

Four hundred and fifty Northern newspaper men will visit the Exposition. These will come in several parties and special arrangements have been made for them. They are all selected.

The negroes are taking a lively interest in their distinctive part in this great Southern Exposition and will entirely fill a spacious building set apart for their use.

COTTON GROWERS.

A Movement to Withhold From Market. COLUMBIA, S. C., August 22.— Captain Richard O'Neal, of this city, in an open letter urges farmers of the South to entirely withhold half this year's cotton crop from market, and give notice to the world that no cotton will be produced next year. The subject is attracting attention in sub-Alliances and it is now under consideration to form a trust in county Alliances in whose hands one half the present crop will be placed, so as to assure its entire retirement from market.

It is pretty certain that something tending to overcome the inordinately bearish tone of the cotton market will be consummated by means of the Alliance. Richland county Alliance to-day unanimously adopted resolution calling upon cotton growers of South Carolina to withhold one-half of the yield of the present crop from market.

HOW THE PRESIDENT IS PAID.

The President's salary is paid to him in monthly instalments of \$4,166.67. The warrant is brought to the White House by a special messenger from the Treasury Department, and after the President has indorsed it as he would an ordinary draft his private secretary deposits it at the Columbia Bank. When the President is out of town the draft is mailed to him. The same method is pursued in paying the Justices of the Supreme Court.
