REPUBLICAN RESOLUTIONS.

The following is the platform of the Republican party in North Carolina adopted in Convention at Raleigh, N. C., Feb. 11, 1872.

Resolved, That the Republican party of North Carolina favors a rapid diminution of the Government debt, and an early extinction of all internal revenue taxation as the exigencies of the Government will permit.

Resolved, That the Republican party of North Carolina favors the passage of a general amnesty bill, and the adoption of all necessary measures for the enforcement and protection of the political rights of all classes of American citizens.

Resolved, That in a free and representative government, the people are the source of all power, and it is the duty of the Legislature to provide efficiently for the general education of the people.

Resolved, That the Republican party of North Carolina favors the establishment of a public fund, and the location of public lands to the purposes of establishing schools in the several States.

Resolved, That we fully endorse the acts of Congress, passed to secure equal rights and protection to the colored people of the United States, and we respectfully recommend a continuance of the present laws.

Resolved, That we cordially endorse the administration of Gov. Caldwell, and recognize the fact that our people may rely upon him to defend their rights and interests.
