The Advantages of the South For Manufacturing.

It is a matter of gratification, but not of surprise, that while the manufacture of cotton goods in the New England States has for several years been comparatively unprofitable, the cotton factories in North Carolina and the South generally, have paid a handsome profit. So far as the manufacture of cotton fabrics is concerned, the South is destined ultimately to monopolize the business.

It is positively asserted in these dispatches, which have been sent to commercial houses in London, that reports respecting the flight of the Amerer, an abandonment of the contest, and the appearance of his son, Yacoub Khan, at Jelalabad, are untrue. 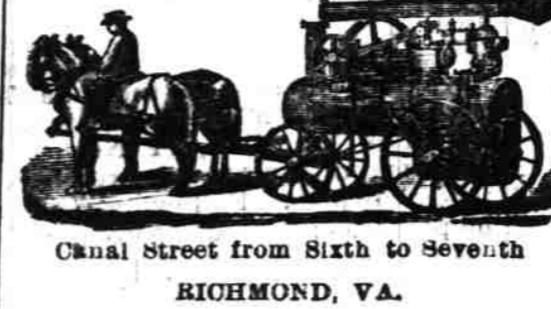
