London, Nov. 28.—A dispatch has been received here from General Buller, giving a list of the casualties among the troops engaged in what was hitherto known here as the battle of Gras Pan, but which is now officially designated the Battle of Enslin.

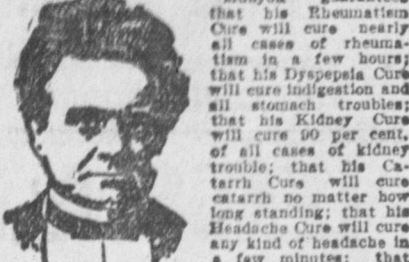
