Goes Down Under Heavy Liverpool, Southern and Western Selling

NET DROP 12 TO 16 POINTS

October Contracts Broke To 10.63, or About 24 Points From Monday's High Records With The Close A Shade Up From The Lowest On Covering

New York, April 21.—Cotton easier today under more or less general realizing and liquidation and closed steady at a net decline of 12 to 16 points.

The market opened six to nine points lower on relatively easy cables and after some irregularly priced sales still further under heavy Liverpool, Wall Street, Southern and Western selling.

It was estimated around the ring that houses with Liverpool connections had sold 100,000 bales here in the last few days, presumably on straight.

New York, April 21.—The most notable feature of today's irregular stock market consisted of frequent periods of relative dullness, a striking contrast to recent feverish sessions.

On the surface there were signs that what is vaguely known as the substantial interests including a large proportion of the professional element, had received operations on the selling side under cover of apparent gains in specialties.

Rock Island again was a disturbing factor, declining below its minimum price of the previous session and constituting one of the duller issues in the list.
