

TOO MUCH JOYNER
IN SECOND OPENER

Former Collegian Holds Capitals To Two Hits; Locals Errors Costly

Too much Joyner, with "Old Sol" as a contributing factor, cost Raleigh the opening game of the second half of the season yesterday, High Point winning by the run-away score of 7 to 1.

The one word, "Joyner," completely accounts for the local team's inability to break into the run column often. Their only tally being a terrific circuit slout by Heimach. Only one other hit was registered off of Joyner during the entire session, that being a single by Munson, which missed being a two-base hit by the narrowest of margins. Other clubs have been hitting Joyner rather frequently recently, but the former collegian had everything that goes to win a ball game yesterday, and used it effectively.

High Point's seven runs may not be accounted for so simply. They certainly are not chargeable to Hughes, for only two of them were earned and Hall's three-base hit, which Munson should have fielded, entered into one of those two. That is where old Sol got his work, affecting Munson, ordinarily the steadiest player on the club. True enough the sun played no favorites and shone as brightly upon the visiting clan as it did upon the home talent, but none of them pack as much beef as the Raleigh center fielder. However, Heimach, the other hefty Capital, seemed to thrive in the extreme heat. Besides cracking out a home run to the club house, he made a beautiful peg home after deeping a three-base hit knocked to deep right field—all the way to the fence, in fact.

Toner also had a bad day despite the fact that he is charged with only one error out of a total of nine chances. However, that error was extremely costly, letting three runs in. In the fourth inning, with two on, Waldron cracked one squarely between Toner's legs. The ball was hit with a terrible wallop and rolled far into the outfield, enabling Waldron to complete the circuit. However, Toner could not throw, allowing at least two balls to go for hits that should have been easy outs. But here there is a marked similarity to Postum. Toner broke in too hard at Danville, where he accepted eight chances without the semblance of a bobble and as a result his arm has gone bad on him. For that reason Ward started Bots in Durham Tuesday, but the regular shortstop is still having trouble with his ankle and may be out for the rest of the week. At that, Toner exhibited a great deal of gameness, making several throws that obviously brought torture to his arm.

One of Toner's assists was recorded jointly with similar marks for Munson, Duvay and McNeill. In the eighth inning Holmes tried to stretch his two-bagger and was finally caught between the bases after four players had handled the apple.

A scratch hit, a stolen base, a base on balls and an error by Munson gave the visitors two in the first inning and a three-base hit, a single, two fielders' choices, a base on balls and Toner's error added four more in the fourth frame. In the seventh Joyner was hit and scored on Irb's triple, giving High Point their seventh and last run.

Heimach's home run fell in the fifth inning.
