Senate and House Committees Will Meot On Measure Monday Morning

The Senate Committee on Salurie and Fem yesterday made radios changes in the hill fixing the salaries of all of the Constitutional State Offi cers except the Governor at \$6,000 each Supreme Court Judges and Superior Court Judges were included in the hill and the other officers were given a flat of the Senate Committee will be pre-sented to a joint meeting of the two Houses Monday morning at alsvan o'clock and a final draft for presentation to the two Houses will be drawn ly the joint committee.

The committee increased the salaries of all judges \$1,090, each. As the bill now stands Justice of the Supreme Court will receive a salary of \$6,000 plus the allowance of \$250,00 and Superior Court Judges will receive a salary of \$5,000, plus an allowance for the actual expenses incident to rotation, not to exceed \$1,500. The heads of State Departments will receive the following salaries: Superintendent of PuPblic Instruction, \$5,500; Secretary of State. \$5,000; Treasurer, \$5,000; Attorney General, \$4,590; Auditor, \$4,500.

In order to benefit the State officers who are to be inducted into office next Wednesday, the measure must become law not later than Tuesday, and it is hoped that a unanimous report will be adopted at the joint meeting Monday. The first amendment offered was by Celonel Benshan Cameron, who stated he had encountered considerable opposition to exceeding the recommenda-tions of Governor Bickett, which provided \$5,000 a year. The original bill, introduced by Senator Long, of Alamance, fixed the sularies of each of the officers at \$6,000 and Senator Cameron's amendment reduced each of the salaries to \$5,000. Members of the committee expressed themselves as votfing for the reduction on the ground that a recommendation of a larger amount would not be adopted, several of them stating the opinion that the original amount was preferable.
