A survey of all the hospitals recently completed shows that there are 1,147 of them. They are distributed as follows: At Hillsboro, 318; Otter, 773; Black Mountain, 5; Morganton, 9; Goldsboro, 15; New Bern, 7; Charlotte, 15; Fairview (Asheville), 19; Cragmont (Black Mountain), 28.
