Charged With First Degree Burglary In Perquimans and Robbery of Aged Man

Hertford, July 20.- Another chapter was added to the relebrated Wooten robbery case here when Judge W. M. Bond remanded three of the defendants to jail without ball after a hearing given them on a writ of habeas corpo-The three defendants are Oscar Lamb, Tom Chappell and Cluries Munds, all white and residents of the neighbor hood where the robbery occurred in the Belviders section of Perquimans county several weeks ago.

These three detendants were impli-cated by one Willis Janes, a negro-who said he was employed by the as sailants to watch on the outside of the home, where Mr. Wooten, an aged wh man, lived alone, and on being given preliminary hearing by Justice of the Peace J. W. Darden, Oscar Lamb, the alleged leader in the plot, and To-Chappell were remanded to jail withou bail and Charles was allowed to give bond of \$1,000, but the latter was al-remanded to jull, being unable to go bond. The State held a subsequent hearing here last Saturday, however, . eure some technical defects in the war rants, the outcome being that all the defendants were charged with first digree burglarly for which they will be tried at the October term of superior

This case grows out of a brutal at tack on the prosecutor which was evi dently perpetented with the intent . kill as well as to tob. The victim about 70 years of age and the injury received at the hands of his assaulant coupled with the loss of \$955, whirepresented the savings of a life time will no doubt cause his early death.




