Receivership Proceedings Have Been Started To Give Henderson Relief From Famine

A hearing of the petition before Judge Calvert resulted in the appointment as temporary receivers of J. H. Bridges, now president of the water company, and Alderman W. A. Hunt.

COTTON CONSUMPTION SHOWS AN INCREASE

Washington, Oct. 14.—Cotton consumed during September amounted to 494,447 bales of lint and 56,423 bales of linters, compared with 457,967 of lint and 47,885 of linters in September last year, the Census Bureau announced today.

The executives, it was announced, wish the wages of train service men returned to the same basis as previous to the increase granted in the labor board decision of July, 1920. This will necessitate a ten per cent reduction, it was said.

Opposition To Test Rates. The decision of the executives, reached in a meeting of the Association of Railway Executives, followed consideration of numerous plans and proposals regarding wages and rates.

An announcement from the labor board that the piece rate system of pay had been restored also added to the excitement and brought reports of dissatisfaction from the unions.
