Apples. The practice of picking the fruit and putting it in heaps for a few days until the skin hardens...

Mixed Farming. Until our country is settled up, and the virgin fertility of the new soil is being exhausted...

Root Crops. Some persons have the idea that it is always best to leave potatoes in the ground till just before it freezes up for the winter...

Pictures. Castile soap and water can be used on oil paintings without danger, care being taken, of course, not to wet the back, or let water through the cracks.
