years issued county orders to the amount of \$9,122.03 a year on an average. Now, what was the amount of county orders issued by the new board of commissioners during their first year? The sum of \$10,607.80, which is nearly \$1500 more than the average annual amount issued by the old commissioners.

Now, we are not charging the new board with extravagance, nor do we accuse them of spending more than they ought to have spent, but we publish the above figures as a matter of simple justice to their predecessors in office.

It is true that the sheriff paid nearly \$1500 less last year on jury and witness fees than he did in 1896 but the jury and witness fees were not properly chargeable to the county commissioners, as are issued by the clerk of the superior court as directed by law. It so happens that the jury and witness fees paid in 1897 amounted to \$2,625.12 and in 1897 to \$1,607.72, but the board of commissioners deserves to be blamed or praised for this difference.
