An Experiment in Oranges.

The Agricultural Department at Washington, which has been experimenting to produce a sweet orange that will stand the tests that have repeatedly swept the orange belt in Florida, has progressed to the point of building the oranges so secured in growing trees in Florida. The hardy orange evolved by the Department is at present termed "the Florida orange." It has been produced by injecting the pulp of the seeds representing the buds of the Japanese trifoliolate orange tree. The trifoliolate grows best north of Philadelphia, but fails to withstand frosty weather. Seedlings of the Florida orange produced promising results, so exceedingly satisfactory, that the experimenters are

now proceeding to plant them.
