Standard cherry trees should be set from twelve to twenty feet apart, the distance depending upon the variety selected. Fifteen feet is a safe distance for the common varieties to be planted upon ordinary soil.

Under the Michigan Division of the League of American Wheelmen is preparing a bill for introduction in the Legislature providing for a road poll tax. It will provide that every able-bodied man in the State between and inclusive of the ages of twenty-one and sixty shall pay this tax, and the receipts will be used to build and repair roads in the State.

Money For Improvement of Roads. Under the Fuller law of 1898, to encourage rural districts in New York to raise their road tax in money, spend it on highways, and abolish the old "working out" road tax system by the farmers, State Controller Morgan has drawn his warrants for the grand total of \$83,897, which is divided among fifteen counties. Westchester being the greatest, \$11,880, New York State pays twenty-five per cent of the cost of the improvements.
