The Supreme Court of this State affirmed, last week, the judgment of the superior court in the case of James Wilcox. He had been sentenced to the penitentiary for thirty years for the murder of his sweetheart, Nellie Cropper, at Elizabeth City. The court held that the evidence was sufficient to justify the jury in rendering a verdict of murder in the second degree. This case has attracted much attention, and there has been a wide difference of opinion as to the defendant's guilt.

The Supreme Court has also affirmed the judgment of the Superior Court of North Carolina in the case of H. F. Snow, against the Carolina Central Railroad Company. In the case of Snow, the plaintiff, who was to testify in a political speech, was assaulted by the company's employees while at the railroad station waiting for the train. He sued the railroad company, and at the trial the jury found in favor of damages. The court held that it was the duty of a railroad company to protect a passenger when at its station or on its train.

The success of the recent election for a good roads commission in Guilford county has already had a beneficial effect upon the market for real estate. Real estate traders had long been waiting for the determination of the question of a land issue. Since the commission has been elected, there is a natural feeling that property along the line of the proposed roads is worth more than it was before.

Mountain Land Slide. Asheville, N. C., June 12.—The side of a mountain caved in on the Southern tracks between Spartanburg and Asheville from Sunday. The landslide occurred near Tyrone, N. C., just at the foot of Salsburg Mountain.
