### Selecting Seed Corn.

In choosing good corn one of the first  
things to be kept in mind is maturity, says  
the *Lake-Side Indicator*. No one  
should be anxious for seed that has not  
become perfectly mature before the  
first period is reached. Of course, one  
can go no farther in the other direction  
and select the small early ears, and  
thus establish a variety that will not  
yield enough.

The size of the ear would possibly  
be the item of less importance, this  
depending upon the altitude and also  
upon the variety. Throughout the  
greater portion of the Middle West the  
ear should be at least one and a half  
inches, and so much the better if they  
are not much longer, providing they are  
not deficient in tip or butt.

A harvest in either phase may be more  
or less profitable, and the discussion  
upon which was seconded by avoided.

The amount of seed should be great  
so as to furnish a reasonable quantity  
of grain for the market, but the amount  
of seed should be small enough to  
allow for a reasonable amount of  
surplus to be saved for the next year.

These quantities, however, are not

to be considered in the selection of  
the variety, but the quality of the grain  
is to be considered.
