CONGRESS will convene next Monday, but it will be the second session of the old Congress (the 61st) and not the first session of the newly elected Congress.

This will be the last session of many Congressmen, both Senators and Representatives, the late election having retired to private life an unusually large number.

THE annual session of the North Carolina Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, is being held this week at Elizabeth City.

These two religious bodies represent the two largest denominations in this State, and their proceedings are of much importance.

Newly Elected Congressmen.

Washington, Nov. 22.—The Democratic representation in the next House will be 227 as against 163 Republicans and 1 Socialist, according to the roster of the House published today.

According to this, Republican Kansas is the only State of size which has a solid Republican delegation. A number, however, contain only 1 Democrat, among those thus included being Iowa, Minnesota, California and Wisconsin.

All of the Southern States have solid Democratic delegations except Maryland, Virginia, Kentucky and Tennessee. Maryland and Virginia each has one Republican, while Tennessee and Kentucky each has two members of that party.

Missouri's delegation consists of 13 Democrats and 3 Republicans. The Nebraska delegation is evenly divided, 3 and 3, as is Maine's 2 and 2; Oklahoma has 2 Republicans and 3 Democrats; Washington is represented by 6 Republicans. All of the States having 1 Representative only are Republican.
