


#### Robert' Position.

Although some packers of caviar in New York report that spoonbill caviar is being marketed here in bulk as low

as 75 cents a pound, the market generally remains at \$1.25 for prime quality, and a few sales are reported at \$1. The quantity has been limited from all sources and, indeed, operators here have not been buying heavily. There has been a scarcity of lake caviar in bulk, and packers report that the prevailing price for this grade has been usually \$1.50 a pound .- Fishing Gazette.


