COST OF HIGH SCHOOL INSTRUCTION GREAT.

To old timers who ran private high schools and had difficulty in collecting \$3. a month per high school pupil, the cost of instruction in the public high schools today seems excessive. Tabulations fund in State School Facts show a tuition cost of over 39 cents a day as the average in the public high schools of the state, while the daily cost of instruction of high school pupils in Currituck county was a little over 70 cents a day, ranging down to 22 cents a day in Lincoln county. In fifty counties the daily cost per pupil for instruction alone was over 39.3 cents. When the cost of transportation, high interest on investment, and a score of other items are counted in, the average daily cost of high school pupils is so large that the state should not be satisfied with anything but the very best results. Teachers and pupils, alike, should be required to cooperate in securing for the state real education for the \$100, or more, a year paid out for each high school pupil.

The average daily cost of elementary instruction in the whole state last year was 18.1 cents.

The daily cost of high school instruction in Chatham county was 32.9 cents, about 6½ cents lower than the state.

HEALTH OFFICERS' INSTITUTE.

An Institute for the health officers of the state wil be conducted at Raleigs by the State Board of Health for a week begining Monday, December 15. The Institute will be conducted by Dr. E. F. Long and H. A. Taylor, deputy state health officers.
