CITY ORDINANCES.

It is ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of New-Berne, That from and after the 1st day of August next, all Barber Shops or Saloons shall close at 10 o'clock, A. M., on Sundays.

It is further Ordained, That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting herewith be, and the same be hereby repealed.

It is further Ordained, That from and after date of the sale of Broad on Sunday shall be confined to the regular places of business, and that said places shall be closed at 10 o'clock, A. M.

It is further Ordained, That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting herewith be, and the same be hereby repealed.

It is further Ordained, That from and after June 1st, 1868, all Vessels, Boats, and other craft, bringing grain to this port, shall be allowed to remain the same for two days, and if desiring to stay for a longer period, the person or persons so desiring shall apply for and take out a retail license.

It is further Ordained, That a tax of One Dollar per dog and upon each and every Dog within the city limits, and the same is hereby levied for the year ending November 30th, 1868. Each dog shall wear a collar with number attached, said number to be furnished by the City Clerk upon the payment of ten cents and the tax.

It is further Ordained, That any and all dogs found within the city limits without such number after July 1st, shall be in charge by the City Marshal and the same shall be destroyed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall pay a fine of Two Dollars for each and every offence.

It is further Ordained, That from and after date on foot, wagon, or other vehicle be allowed to stand upon any of the streets of the city, and sell goods or merchandise therefrom, after 9 o'clock, A. M. Provided, That this Ordinance shall not apply to vehicles coming from without the city limits.

It is further Ordained, That the Ordinance in relation to the sale of grain by weight be, and the same is hereby repealed.

It is further Ordained, That section seventeen of the City License Tax Ordinance be, and the same is hereby repealed.

It is further Ordained, That from and after date, any and all persons (except Policemen, while in the discharge of their duty) who shall discharge firearms with- in the city limits, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall pay a fine of Two Dollars for each and every offence.

It is further Ordained, That the Meat and Fish stands at the People's Market be allowed to remain open until 9 o'clock, A. M. Sundays.

An Ordinance in Relation to Velocipedes.

Ride or Drive Velocipedes upon any of the sidewalks of the city, under a penalty of Two Dollars for each and every offence.
