It is Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Alder-men of the City of New-Berns. That from and after date all Barber Shops or aloons shall close at 10 o'clock, a. m., on Sundays. Be it further Ordained, That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting herewith be, and the same

It is further Ordained. That from and after date, the sale of Bread on Sunday shall be confined to the regular places of business, and that said places shall close at 9 o'clock, a. m.

Be it further Ordained. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed.

It is further Ordained. That from and after June 1st, 1868, all Vessels. Beats, and other crafts, bringing grain to this port, shall be allowed to retail the same for two days, and if desiring to retail for a longer period, the person or persons so desiring shall apply for and take out a retail licence.

It is further Ordained. That a tax of One Dollar per head upon each and every Dog within the city limits.

head upon each and every Dog within the city limits, be, and the same is hereby levied for the year ending December 30th, 1820. Each dog shall wear a collar with a number attached, said number to be furnished by the City Clerk upon the payment of ten cents and the tax.


