AN ORDINANCE To lay Taxes, and Provide for the Support of the City Government.

Sec. 1. It is ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of New-Berne, that for the fiscal year ending June 30th 1870, a tax of one per cent upon the value of all real estate within the limits of the corporation, be and the same is hereby laid to be collected as follows: Sec. 2. It is ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of New-Berne, that the occupants of each and every lot in the city, in and in case the lot is unoccupied, the owner thereof, is hereby ordered to collect, and deposit in the city treasury, or other suitable receptacle, all refuse matter, garbage, ash, and filth of every description, that may accumulate on their respective lots, dwellings, or business premises, and to place such refuse or other receptacles, on the sidewalks in front of their respective lots, on Monday and Tuesday mornings of each week, before the hour of 7 A. M.
