Landon or had won In 46 of the 48 states in $a_{n}$ overwhelming electoral endorsement of new deal anti-depression policies. Governor Landon concedéd Mr. Roosevelt's reelection shortly after midnight Tuesday. <br> Only Maine and Vermont remained true to the Republican tradition, according to incomplete United Press tabulations. New Hampshire. listed through the night as one of the liftle group of three probable Landon states shifted at 8:30 a. m. (e.s.t.) to the Roosevelt column.
