where in this newspaper, shows that the association has enjoyed an increase of approximately \$40,000.00 since the first of the year, which is commendable. Investors and borrower are maturing their installment stock in eighty-two months, which means that the earnings of the association have to exceed 6 per cent in order to mature in this short time. The association pays 5 per cent annually to its full paid stockholders. Checks are mailed on June 30th and December 31st. The secretary treasurer has just mailed the dividend checks due June 30th. It is found that dividend stockholders have received on their investments for the first six months of this year, \$8,621.22.

During the past twelve months in North Wilkesboro and surrounding territory saws and hammers have been heard constantly. Home construction is moving forward at a brisk pace. Nearly all of the homes being constructed are financed on a monthly payment plan and most of the loans are being made by the local building and loan association. The building and loan associations exceed for the purpose of aiding families in home construction and with growing indications of better business conditions within the next few months the prospects for continued progress in the building trades appear to be bright. All prospective new home owners are invited to take advantage of building and loan finance plans. Those desiring to create a saving for the future are also invited to invest their money with the local associations. Those who are interested in either home building or savings are cordially invited to see J. B. Williams, secretary treasurer, of the North Wilkesboro Building & Loan Association, with offices in the Bank of North Wilkesboro building.

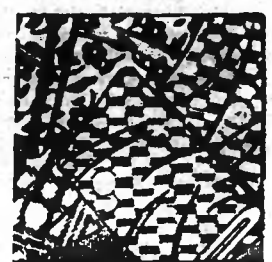

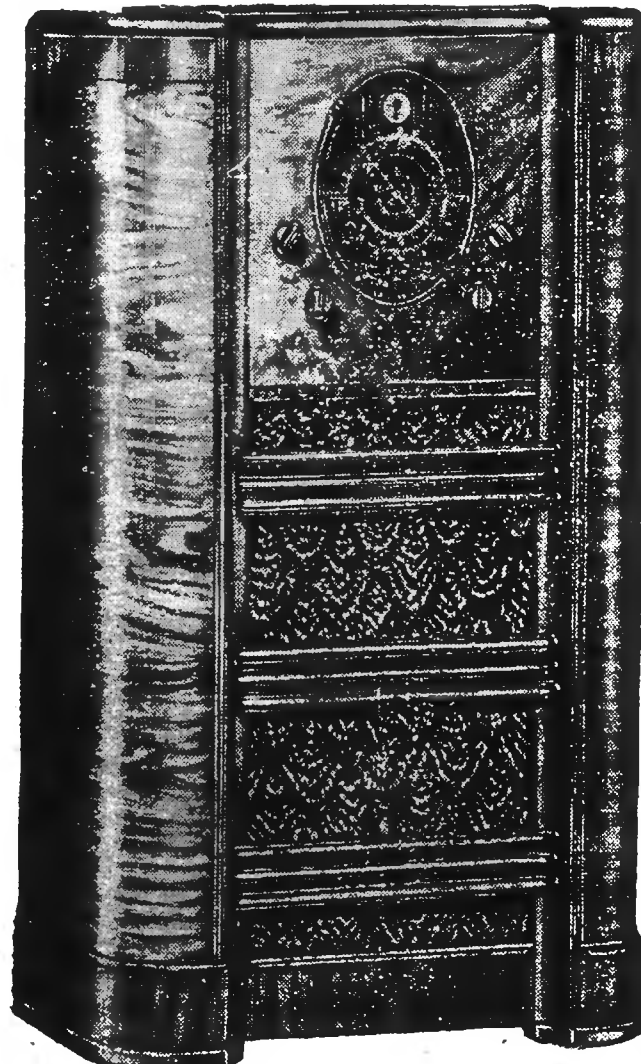

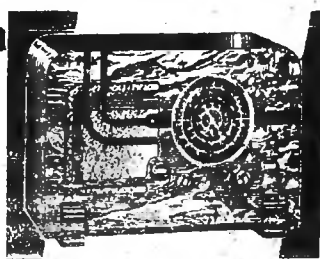
