

Re-Use Of Lumber From Old Buildings

The U. S. Forest Products Laboratory, at Madison, Wis., very frequently is asked if wood that has been used in old buildings is satisfactory for other purposes or for reconstruction.

If the material is free from decay, insect attack, checks, splits, or other defects, it should be good for re-use for any purpose for which the lumber was originally suitable.

The principal cause of damage to wood in buildings is decay and decay cannot occur unless a certain amount of water is present says the Laboratory.
